The Timbavati Private Nature Reserve forms part of the Greater Kruger ecosystem and spans over 53,000 hectares of open savanna, woodland, and riverine habitat. The reserve is globally famous as the birthplace of the white lions and is home to a rich diversity of wildlife, including the Big Five.

The Timbavati Explorer offers a relaxed, private bush experience for friends and family wanting to explore this remarkable wilderness at their own pace. Guests stay in a private lodge-style accommodation featuring four bedrooms and bathrooms, as well as beautiful outdoor showers and comfortable living spaces.

The camp is set in a beautiful location next to a riverbed, offering peaceful views and a true connection to the surrounding wilderness. The property includes a lounge and kitchen area, allowing guests to enjoy the convenience of self-catering while keeping refreshments cool and accessible.

Guests may also choose to arrange a private chef to prepare meals. This flexible setup allows you to shape your bush experience exactly as you prefer.
