DAY 1 & 2: WALK ON THE WILD SIDE

OVERVIEW

This immersive 3-day Wilderness Walking Trail is designed for true adventurers and nature lovers seeking a deeper connection with the African bush. Operating within the 8,000-hectare Maseke Game Reserve in the Greater Kruger ecosystem, this experience focuses on exploration on foot through rugged, undulating terrain.

Guided by Magagazi's professional walking guides and tracking team, guests experience the bush at ground level – reading tracks, understanding animal behaviour, and learning the subtle language of the wilderness. Nights are spent in a fully serviced mobile camp, allowing the journey to move with the landscape.

This is a safari stripped back to its essence: walking, learning, and being present.

DAILY EXPERIENCE

DAY 1 - ARRIVAL & FIRST WALK

Guests arrive in the Maseke Game Reserve and are welcomed by the Magagazi guiding team. After a safety briefing and orientation, the first guided walk begins, setting the tone for the days ahead. The afternoon ends at a secluded mobile camp location, where sundowners are enjoyed around the fire before dinner under the stars.

DAY 2 - FULL WILDERNESS IMMERSION

The day begins early with coffee by the fire, followed by an extended morning walk through varied terrain. After brunch and rest at camp, the afternoon walk explores new areas of the reserve. Evenings include a relaxed sundowner and a short night drive, offering the chance to encounter nocturnal wildlife and predators.

DAY 3: WALK ON THE WILD SIDE

DAY 3 - FINAL WALK & DEPARTURE

A final morning walk allows guests to consolidate their tracking skills and bush knowledge before returning to camp for breakfast. The trail concludes mid-morning with departure from the reserve.

ACCOMMODATION - MOBILE CAMP

Each night is spent at a different wilderness location, offering a sense of journey and discovery.

- Spacious dome tents (sleeping 2 guests each)
- Individual mattresses with bed linen, duvets, and pillows
- En-suite bucket shower and chemical toilet per tent
- Fully set up and broken down by the Magagazi team

The central camp area includes:

- A fire-pit with safari chairs
- A fresco dining table
- Small bar area
- Open views over river systems and vast wilderness

While meals are prepared by the camp chef, guests are free to relax, reflect, and soak in the atmosphere of the bush.

ACTIVITIES

- Daily guided walking safaris (several hours per day)
- Tracking and bush interpretation
- Evening sundowners
- Short night game drive for nocturnal species
- Fireside storytelling and bush discussions

INFORMATION

FITNESS & REQUIREMENTS

- A moderate to good level of fitness is required
- Guests should be comfortable walking for several hours per day
- This trail is best suited to adventurous, nature-focused travellers

WHAT'S INCLUDED

- 3 days / 2 nights fully guided walking safari
- Professional Magagazi walking guide and tracking team
- All meals and snacks on trail
- Fully serviced mobile camp accommodation
- Night game drive
- Reserve entry fees

CAMP COMFORTS & SETUP

- Four canvas dome tents, each sleeping two guests on comfortable swags/mattresses
- En-suite bush bathrooms with bucket showers and chemical toilets
- Standing hand basins refreshed morning and afternoon with warm water
- Central mess area for relaxed dining and camp gatherings
- Evening campfire for storytelling and fireside meals
- Solar-powered lanterns throughout camp, with one per tent
- Fully catered experience, including:
 - Light early-morning breakfast
 - Packed brunch enjoyed in the bush
 - Afternoon snacks
 - Wholesome three-course dinners each evening
- Open game-viewing vehicle for evening safaris and transfers into and out of the reserve

LOCATION & LANDSCAPE

Set within the Maseke Balule Game Reserve in the Greater Kruger, this private 8,000-hectare wilderness lies between Hoedspruit and Phalaborwa in Limpopo Province. With open borders to the Kruger National Park, the reserve offers exceptional biodiversity – from the flowing Olifants River to rugged mountain ridges and ancient boulder-strewn koppies. The varied terrain makes it an extraordinary area to explore on foot.

DAILY EXPERIENCES

- Guided walking safaris led by a professional trails guide and tracker
 - Morning walk: ±3-4 hours
 - Bush brunch and rest period
 - Afternoon walk: ±2-3 hours
- Evening game drives within the Maseke Balule Reserve
- Birdwatching and interpretive bush time
- Stargazing around the campfire in a remote, low-light wilderness

WHAT'S INCLUDED

- Accommodation in a fully serviced mobile camp
- Professional trails guide and tracker
- Private chef and all meals & snacks
- Daily guided walking safaris
- Evening game drives
- Transfers between Three Bridges and camp

AGE POLICY

- Children 12 years and older are welcome on the trail

- Comfortable walking shoes and long trousers
- Light, neutral-coloured clothing
- Sun hat, sunglasses, and sunblock
- Camera and binoculars
- Small day backpack (camping equipment is provided)
- Winter (May-October): warm jacket, beanie, and gloves – mornings can be cold
