ITINERARY BREAKDOWN

- 2 nights camping at each camp inside Kruger National Park

DAY 1: JOHANNESBURG TO KRUGER NATIONAL PARK

Departure: 7:40 a.m. from O.R. Tambo International Airport

Begin your journey with a scenic drive north to Phalaborwa, the gateway town to Kruger National Park. Relax and take in the landscapes as your adventure begins.

Meet Your Team

Your Magagazi Safari Company guiding team greet you on arrival. Enjoy a delicious local lunch to fuel up for the day ahead.

Into the Wild

Step through Phalaborwa Gate and into Kruger National Park. Your first game drive winds through Mopani and Bushwillow woodlands, home to roaming elephants, buffalo and incredible wildlife. Every turn brings a new adventure and photo opportunity.

Sunset at Letaba

Arrive at Letaba Camp, nestled along the Letaba River, around 6:00 p.m. Take in breath-taking views, explore the Park shop, relax by the swimming pool, or visit the Great Elephant Hall - a tribute to Kruger's majestic elephants.

Dinner Under the Stars

As night falls, enjoy an open-fire dinner, savouring local flavours while the sounds of the African wilderness set the scene for an unforgettable evening.



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DAY 2: KRUGER NATIONAL PARK | CENTRAL SECTION

Sunrise Safari

The day begins as the first light touches the Letaba landscapes. Herds of buffalo roam, elephants wander gracefully, and leopards watch silently from the trees. Along the river, hippos and crocodiles make their quiet presence known—a magical start to your adventure.

Breakfast in Nature

Pause for a picnic breakfast surrounded by birdsong and the gentle rustle of the bush. The drive back to camp reveals more wildlife surprises along the way.

Letaba Camp Retreat

Take a refreshing swim, browse the park shop, or simply relax and soak in the serene surroundings.

Afternoon Discovery

Venture out again as the sun casts golden hues over the savannah. Explore hidden corners and catch glimpses of antelope, elephants, and elusive predators—each moment telling its own wild story.

Dinner & Evening

Return to camp for a delicious dinner, reflecting on a day full of unforgettable experiences in the heart of Kruger.



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DAY 3: LETABA TO SATARA | CENTRAL SECTION

River Sunrise Safari

Begin the day with a sunrise drive along the Letaba River, moving east through landscapes home to a shy lion pride. As the bush awakens, every bend in the road holds promise.

Breakfast at Camp

Return to Letaba Camp for a hearty breakfast before continuing your journey.

Journey South to Satara

Travel south through open savannah grasslands, a haven for zebras and wildebeest. Upon arrival at Satara, enjoy a freshly prepared lunch.

Satara Camp Experience

Nestled in Kruger's grasslands, Satara is renowned for its grazing wildlife. A nearby waterhole offers excellent game viewing right from camp.

Night Drive Adventure

After dinner at the camp restaurant (own expense), head out on a guided night drive with a trained ranger. Venture into the darkness in search of nocturnal wildlife and big cats on the move.



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DAY 4: WILDLIFE ENCOUNTERS | CENTRAL SECTION

Morning Game Drive

Set off along the scenic N'wanetsi River road, famous for exceptional sightings. Dense bush shelters leopards, open plains attract cheetahs, and lions are frequently spotted.

Breakfast with a View

Enjoy breakfast at a picnic site overlooking the dramatic Sweni River gorge, surrounded by the sounds of the wild.

Land of the Super Pride

Continue through an area home to one of Kruger's legendary super prides—up to 20 lions. Return to camp for lunch and time to relax.

Afternoon Safari

Explore the Sweni road in the afternoon, searching for more lions and, with luck, elusive wild dogs.

Dinner at Camp

As the sun sets, return to camp for a freshly prepared dinner and a well-earned rest.



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DAY 5: SATARA TO SKUKUZA | SOUTHERN SECTION

Morning in Cheetah Country

Begin with coffee before exploring Satara's open grasslands—prime habitat for cheetahs.

Breakfast & Scenic Transfer

After breakfast, travel south toward Skukuza. Along the way, pause at iconic waterholes known for attracting diverse wildlife, including lions.

Lunch by the Sabie River

Arrive at Skukuza around midday and enjoy lunch at the camp restaurant overlooking the Sabie River (own expense).

Skukuza at Leisure

Spend the afternoon relaxing—swim in the pool, browse the shops, or stroll along the river walkway.

Afternoon Game Drive

Head out on a game drive in search of Skukuza's famous lion pride.

Dinner Under the Stars

End the day with a special dinner served under the African sky in a makeshift bush restaurant.



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DAY 6: SOUTHERN SECTION IMMERSION

Sunrise Safari

At first light, venture into wildlife-rich areas with expert guides. Each moment carries anticipation and the promise of discovery.

Breakfast in the Bush

Enjoy breakfast at a scenic picnic site before returning to camp to relax.

Afternoon Exploration

After lunch, set out again to explore the park's diverse ecosystems, returning to camp at sunset.

Bush Dinner Experience

Dinner is prepared over an open fire, filling the air with the aromas of the bush. Dine under the stars for a truly magical evening.



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DAY 7: SKUKUZA TO BERG EN DAL

Guided Bush Walk

Start the day on foot with a trained ranger, learning animal tracking skills and noticing details often missed from a vehicle.

Breakfast & Farewell

Return to camp for breakfast before heading south toward Berg en Dal.

Into the Mountains

Berg en Dal lies in a lush, mountainous region with riverine forests and high rainfall—ideal habitat for elephants, leopards, and Kruger's highest concentration of rhinos.

Afternoon Game Drive

Explore this dramatic landscape on an afternoon safari, where terrain and wildlife combine for exciting sightings.

Dinner at Camp

Return at sunset to a crackling campfire and a freshly prepared dinner in the bush.



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DAY 8: BERG EN DAL

Sunrise Safari

Enjoy morning coffee before setting out along winding rivers. Watch for leopards in low branches and search for elephants, white rhinos, and the rare black rhino.

Breakfast in Nature

Stop at a scenic picnic site to enjoy breakfast surrounded by the sounds of the bush.

Relax at Camp

Late morning and lunch are spent at leisure—swim, explore the shop, visit the waterhole, or enjoy a self-guided walk.

Final Afternoon Drive

Head out for one last safari in this biodiverse region.

Dinner at the Restaurant

Dinner tonight is at the camp restaurant (own expense), the perfect time to reflect on your journey.



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DAY 9: KRUGER TO JOHANNESBURG

Farewell Safari

Enjoy one final game drive along the Crocodile River, searching for predators and, with luck, the resident wild dog pack.

Breakfast & Departure

Return for breakfast and farewell to Kruger National Park.

Return to Johannesburg

Transfer back to Johannesburg, arriving between 5:00 pm and 6:00 pm.
