Set in the Timbavati Private Nature Reserve, adjoining the Kruger National Park, this longer conservation experience offers a chance to truly immerse yourself in the bush. Over several days, you will explore the wilderness on morning walks and afternoon game drives with professional guides, while learning from wildlife veterinarians, reptile and mammal conservationists, and anti-poaching teams who share their knowledge from the field. A visit to the Timbavati Museum adds a fascinating glimpse into the region's history, culture and iconic wildlife, including the rare white lions.

All meals and refreshments are provided, with plenty of time between activities to watch wildlife from camp, reflect quietly on the bush around you and engage in conversations about the challenges and successes of conservation.

This experience is perfect for those who want more than a standard safari, who wish to deepen their knowledge of the bush, witness the results of dedicated conservation efforts and leave with a lasting connection to the wild.

OPTIONAL ADD ON: HELICOPTER ANTI-POACHING PATROL

Embark on a one-hour helicopter patrol with a conservation pilot, assisting in the search for signs of illegal activity, snares or injured animals. For many, this is a once-in-a-lifetime opportunity to experience the Klaserie from the skies while taking part in vital conservation work.

EXPLORING THE BUSH THROUGH AN ECOLOGICAL LENS

A conservation journey through the bush is a deep dive into the interconnected world of nature. Together, we'll explore how every element, from towering trees to the tiniest insects, plays a role in keeping ecosystems balanced. You will gain a new perspective on the bush through:

- **Ecological Insights**

Understanding how habitats function, how species depend on each other and why conservation matters.

- **Mammal Behaviour**

Observing animal interactions, predator-prey dynamics, and the subtle ways mammals communicate and adapt.

- **The World of Birds**

Discovering the incredible diversity of birdlife, their calls, nesting habits and migration stories.

- **Arthropods, Amphibians & Reptiles**

Appreciating the often-overlooked creatures that form the backbone of healthy ecosystems.

- **Tracks & Signs**

Learning how to read nature's clues – footprints, scat, feeding marks and trails – to piece together the hidden stories of the bush.

GENERAL TRAVEL INFORMATION

- **Weather & Rain**

Temperatures can range from 10-25°C in winter to 20-35°C in summer. Rainfall is mostly in the form of magnificent, electrical thunderstorms during summer evenings.

- **Game Viewing**

Wildlife is present year-round, but visibility varies. Winter offers easier spotting of animals due to less vegetation. Summer brings new-born animals and migratory birds, adding vibrancy to the bush.

- **Malaria Risk**

The area is low malaria-risk, so all guests are advised to consult a healthcare professional regarding prophylactics before travel. Insect repellent and protective clothing are recommended, especially during dusk and dawn.

- **Currency & Payments**

South African Rand (ZAR) is the local currency. Credit/ debit cards are widely accepted at lodges, but carrying some cash for small purchases is useful.

- Neutral-coloured shirts and pants for game drives
- Warm layers for mornings/ evenings
- Comfortable shoes
- Hat and light rain jacket (November-March)
- Sun hat, sunglasses and sunblock
- Warm jacket, beanie and gloves for winter months (May-October)
